The essential elements of each lesson are listed below. All levels will study the same lesson, using age-appropriate materials. Note: Levels 1 and 2 learn only the underlined portion of each passage.

Theme Passage: Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:57)

Day 1 Story: God Wins the Victory! (Exodus 17:8-16; Luke 22:47-24:9)

Aim: How has God won the victory for us?

Truth: God sent his Son, Jesus, to win the victory for us.

Memory Treasure: Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Truth: God's team trusts that God is on its side.

Memory Treasure: Trust in the Long with all your hear) and lean not on your own

Day 4 Story: Caleb and Joshua Serve the Lord (Numbers 13:1-14:38; Deuteronomy 31:1-8)

Aim: Whom does God's team serve?

Truth: God's team serves God and others.

who belong to the family of believers. (Galatians 6:10)

Key Word: Serve!

Aim: How does God's team celebrate?

Memory Treasure: Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits. (Psalm 103:2)
